Hello and welcome to Unit 5 of Creation Narrative 1. Our focus for this unit will be the introduction of sin into the world. Specifically, we're going to investigate three main teaching points. In this unit, we will first start by looking at how humanity chose to vandalize the *shalom* of God. Here we will take a look at how God intended to be in relationship with humanity, the nature of sin, and the first act of sin in the garden.
