Lesson 2 – Identity of God

Key verse: "Remember the former things of old, for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times things that are not yet done, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure'" (Isaiah 46:9-10)

Concept: A complete definition of God is something that is impossible to do. However a basic definition of God includes these facts: God is an invisible personal, eternal spirit who is absolute perfection. He is the only God that has existed or that ever will exist. He is not the same as His creation, but is Lord over it. He is also personally involved in the affairs of the universe. Finally, He is knowable. It is possible for His creation to have a personal relationship with Him.
